Poster presentation instructions

Participants are invited to present results of their clinical and technical work as a poster presentation. Please note that all posters will be displayed in the exhibition hall throughout the conference and on the conference app.

Please note the following guidelines:

Poster format

- 1. Your poster is to be in a <u>portrait</u> format, recommended size is A0. Should posters not meet these criteria they may be excluded from presentation at the conference.
- 2. Date of preparation to be included at the bottom of the poster.
- 3. Lettering for poster presentations needs to be legible at 2m and this requires characters of not less than 8mm in height and a line thickness of 0.7mm. Poster boards approximately 0.9m wide and 2.0m high will be available. These take Velcro fixers only, please provide your own. Please note that pins or any other fixing likely to cause damage to the poster panels is not acceptable.
- 4. References should appear in the text thus: Surname/s with date in brackets e.g. Jones (1989), Jones and Smith (1989) Jones et al (1989), or, after a statement: (Jones 1989; Jones and Smith 1989; Jones et al 1989). At the end of the text, list the surname/s and initials with the date in brackets, the name of the journal quoted and the volume number, followed by the first and last page numbers. References should be listed in alphabetical order.
